Quiet Time

Put a litter box in a private, quiet area away from noise. If the litter box is in the basement, keep it away from the furnace, water heater, or any “scary” sounding thing.

Outside the Box

When a cat is suddenly going outside the litter box and it is not a medical problem, check if someone changed the brand or type of litter. Cats don’t like change and don’t care that you saved money! Many cats prefer unscented litter.

Location, Location, Location!

Does your cat live in a multi-level home? TIP: Put a litter box on each level. Why: Who wants to go up or downstairs when the urge calls?



The Brush Off

Brush your cat often (daily if possible) to help prevent hair balls. A FURmintor® does an amazing job of reducing shedding and hairballs.

Watering

Water fountains are fun to watch and encourage cats to drink.

The Clean Up

TIP: Keep a scooper next to the box and use it often. Some cats are really picky and won’t go in a dirty litter box.

Slow-mo

To calm a cat, very, very slowly blink your eyes. When your cat does this to you they are showing affection.



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
